7 Results

- Based on responses to a questionnaire received from the participant, the overall content of the program was very well evaluated.
- The participant was strongly interested in the high level of consciousness displayed by metropolitan hospital staff vis-à-vis preventing hospital-acquired infections, so that he made comments that it was necessary to spread the knowledge obtained in the training program within his hospital in Taipei. Furthermore, he expressed a hope to learn more how to educate hospital staff members as well.
- Over the five days of the training program, a deeper understanding regarding the hospital-acquired infection prevention strategies of both Taipei City and Tokyo Metropolitan hospitals was developed. Moreover, the eagerness of the participant when undergoing instruction allowed the receiving institution to learn a lot as well.
